FAQs

Q: How many students will be in each camp?

A: Up to 12 students can enroll in each camp.

Q: Do you provide lunch and snacks?

A: No, your student should bring any snacks they need and a packed lunch (if they are a full-day camper).

Q: When should I drop off and pick up my student?

A: We ask that you drop off your student no more than 10 minutes before their camp and pick up your student no more than 15 minutes after their camp. Students picked up more than 15 minutes after their camp will be charged a \$35 late pickup fee. We do not offer before care or after care at this time.

Q: Do you offer a sibling discount?

A: No, but we do offer an early registration discount. If you enroll by March 15 and use code EARLYBIRD at checkout, you will receive 20% off your total purchase. With this discount, half-day camps are \$160/week (save \$40) and full-day camps are \$320/week (save \$80)!

Q: When is my full payment due?

A: A \$50 deposit is required to reserve your student's spot. Full payment of the balance is required by 9:00 AM on the Monday one week prior to your student's camp start date (i.e., 7 days prior to camp).

Q: What if I need to cancel?

A: We understand that plans can change. Please review our cancellation policy below:

More than 7 Days Before Camp: You will receive a full refund (minus the \$50 deposit) if you cancel more than 7 days before your camp begins. This means cancellations must be made before 9:00 AM on the Monday one week prior to your child's camp start date.

Fewer than 7 Days Before Camp: Cancellations made within 7 days of the camp start date or during the camp are not eligible for a refund. This includes cancellations made after 9:00 AM on the Monday one week prior to your child's camp start date.

The Artful Axolotl: Painting & Clay



Students will use acrylics to paint their artful axolotl on canvas and will then sculpt their axolotl out of clay.

Clay Animal Masks



Students will create a clay mask of an animal of their choice using a photo reference for details.

Claytopia: Anthropomorphic Animals in Clay



Students will create a whimsical animal figure with human characteristics using clay hand-building techniques! They will learn about the work of artist J.J. Grandville for inspiration.

Swimming Sea Turtles on Canvas



Students will use acrylic paint to create adorable sea turtle paintings on canvas.

Creatures on Canvas



Students will use their imagination to design their own creature and then paint them using acrylics.

Fantasy Art Creations



Students will get to spend a week in fantasy land working with clay and acrylic paint.

Fun with Clay: Monsters, Mugs, and More!



Students will create 3 clay projects while learning techniques to make coil pots, pinch pots, and drape pots. Experience clay hand building at its best!

Plaster Masks: Design, Create, Decorate!



Students will create their own mask by making a plaster mold of their face. This is an experience they will always remember! They get to design and decorate their mask.

Painting Masterpieces with Pastels



Students will learn to use beautiful pastel chalk to recreate a masterpiece. The results are amazing!

African Clay Masks



Students will learn about this rich and inspiring traditional art form and create a mask of their own.

Pop ARTist Workshop: Icons in Color



Students will complete a bold and vibrant pop art portrait of their favorite pop artist (or of themselves!) using a color palette inspired by their favorite era or album.

Printmaking on Fabric: Design Your Own Tote Bag and T-Shirt



Students will learn about printmaking and how to create their own designs. They will use linoleum blocks and fabric ink to create their own print on a t-shirt and canvas tote bag.

"Oh, the Art You'll Create!": A Dr. Seuss Inspired Creative Week



Students will learn about the whimsical style of Dr. Seuss. They will build clay creatures and design imaginative characters while developing their confidence in drawing, painting, and sculpture.

Cute Kawaii Creations: Painting and Clay



Students create adorable clay Kawaii characters and learn how to draw and paint Kawaii characters using acrylics and watercolor!

Pokemon Artistic Odyssey



Students draw iconic Pokemon characters and paint a unique Pokemon-inspired artwork. Plus, they will use clay to sculpt their very own Pokemon creations.

Intro to Pixel Art: Lego, Minecraft, and More!



Students will learn how to translate a famous piece of art into a pixel grid. They will build a recreation of a famous painting and paint a pixelated version of the same art on a gridded canvas!

Calling All Swifties: In Your Painting Era



Your child will learn to paint their favorite artist, Taylor Swift! Students will work on canvas with acrylics and create a painting to enjoy for years to come!

Clay Jewelry Making



Students will make beads and medallions from earthenware and polymer clay and combine them with other beads and materials to create necklaces, bracelets, and more!

Time Travel Creations



Students will travel back in time to a week of steampunk/sci-fi clay creations. This is a great introduction to sculpting techniques and practicing texture and form.

Stranger Things Revealed: Mixed Media & Clay



Students will learn how to create a 3D pop-up painting using air-dry clay. They will also be introduced to sculpting techniques and will practice creating form and texture.

Clay Favorite Food Creations



Students will create an entire meal, including utensils and napkins, from clay. They will then glaze their whole meal.

Beginning Still-Life Painting



Students will learn how to draw a still-life, transfer their drawing to canvas, and finish their painting in acrylics!

Make 15" Clay Coil Pot!



This one is big fun! Students will design, build, and glaze a 15" TALL coil pot.

Van Gogh's Apprentice: Painting on Canvas



Students will learn about the work of Vincent Van Gogh and will create their own version of one of his paintings.

Stained Glass Creations



Students will learn to design and create "stained glass" projects using simulated "lead" and colorful glass paint (Gallery Glass).

Wooden Bird Houses



Students will design and decorate adorable bird houses using a variety of different media!

Beautiful Balsa: Carving and Painting



Students will design, carve, and paint balsa wood sculptures and make prints from foam blocks.

Impressionist Self-Portraits



Students will learn about the Impressionist movement and create their own Impressionist self portrait!

Colorful Chameleons on Canvas



Students will complete an acrylic painting of a chameleon, complete with “puff” texture acrylic paint.

Tropical Art Paradise



Students will create works inspired by a tropical paradise! Students will make tempera paintings of tropical fish, clay turtles or fish, mixed media lighthouses, sand art, and more!

A Brush with Nature: Watercolor Painting



Students will begin with a drawing and end with a beautiful watercolor landscape painting!

Recreating a Masterpiece: Painting and Clay




Students will learn about a famous artist of their choice and recreate one of their iconic paintings! They will then select an element from their painting to create out of clay.

Anime/Manga Workshop: Character and Storyboard Creation



Students will develop and draw their own unique character! They will learn anatomy drawing skills as they create their character, and will then develop the story in which their character comes to life!

Introduction to Digital Drawing and Animation



Students will learn the basics of digital art by creating original characters. They will also learn the basics of traditional animation to animate their characters

Wild About Wicked



Students will take an artistic adventure in Oz, creating their own emerald medallion, mixed media portraits of Elphaba and Glinda, a canvas painting of the Emerald City, and a sparkly wand or wizard's staff!

Lighthouse Paintings on Canvas



Students will learn how to draw and paint their beautiful lighthouse on canvas!

Beginning Yarn Arts Camp



Students will get to create five awesome projects during this camp: a friendship bracelet, a mini coaster or mug rug, a bookmark or headband, a crocket flower, and a tiny pillow
